AIOC Class Eligibility

OBEDIENCE

Novice A: If you have trained or exhibited a dog <u>that has earned a CDX title</u>, or equivalent under any organization, you must enter Novice B.

Open A: If you have trained or exhibited a dog <u>that has earned a UD title</u>, or equivalent under any organization, you must enter Open B.

Utility A: If you have trained or exhibited a dog <u>that has earned a MOTCH title</u>, or equivalent under any organization, you must enter Utility B.

To enter an Obedience A class, the handler must be the owner, co-owner, or a member of their immediate family, and they must handle the dog in all exercises: <u>They may only enter one dog in the Novice or Open class; more than one dog per handler is permitted in Utility</u>.

Note: A dog is only eligible to enter one class per trial with the exception that a dog that has earned a Utility title may enter Open B and Utility B in the same obedience trial.

RALLY OBEDIENCE

Rally Novice A: Any dog that has earned a Rally Novice (RN) title or <u>Obedience title other than Pre-Novice</u>, or equivalent of either under any organization, must enter Rally Novice B. Any handler who has exhibited a dog through a CDX title, or equivalent in any organization, must enter Rally Novice B.

Rally Advanced A: Any dog that has earned an RA title or <u>Obedience title other than Pre-Novice</u>, or equivalent of either under any organization, must go in Rally Advanced B. Any handler who has trained or trialed a dog to a CDX title, or equivalent in any organization, must enter Rally Advanced B.

Rally Excellent A: Any dog that has earned an RE title or <u>Obedience title other than Pre-Novice</u>, must go in Rally Excellent B. Any handler who has trained or trialed a dog to a CDX title, must enter Rally Excellent B.

To enter a Rally A class, the handler must be the owner, co-owner, or a member of their immediate family and they may enter more than one dog in the class.

Note: A dog is only eligible to enter one class per trial with the exception that a dog that has earned a Rally Excellent title may enter Advanced B and Excellent B in the same trial.

Note for both Obedience and Rally: If a dog enters two trials in one day and completes a title at the first trial, they must be entered in the second trial as Exhibition or move up to the next level, <u>unless</u> the title completed is:

- a) Open, in which case they may enter and compete in Open B;
- b) <u>Utility</u>, in which case they may enter and compete in either Open B or Utility B, or both to earn MOTCH points;
- c) Advanced, in which case they may enter and compete in Advanced B;
- d) Excellent in which case they may be entered in either Advanced B or Excellent B or both to earn RAE points.
